## CHURCH FOR THE YOUNG CHILD

We rejoice in Christ's invitation: "Let the little children come to me and forbid them not." Our goal is to help parents teach their children how to sit and worship with their family. Infants and young children are always welcome in our worship service, and their occasional unexpected voices simply add "happy sounds" to our praise of God. If a child is making enough noise to interfere with other people's worship, we ask that you walk them out of the main sanctuary, wait for them to quiet down and then return to the sanctuary with them. It is important to show kids that making noise doesn't get them out of church. You may feel awkward leaving a couple of times during the service, but we understand. You may find it helpful to sit in the back, near the doors to make the process a little easier.







## **New Adult Ed: Anger, Injustice, and the Psalms**

We live in a world full of injustice and violence. We feel angry and helpless at what we see happening in the news. Oftentimes, as Christians we struggle with our anger over such things, and wonder, "Is it okay for me to be angry?" In turning to Scripture we see a category of the Psalms, known as imprecatory psalms, that deal with feelings of anger over injustice. However, in reading these Psalms we become very uncomfortable over the violent imagery and language being used. Over the next few weeks our adult education class will be exploring the nature of these Psalms, understanding the reason for their existence, and seeing how we can incorporate their usage into our own prayer lives as we wrestle with our own feelings of anger over the injustices in our world today. We hope you will come and wrestle with us and be challenged in your thinking on how God calls us to view injustice through a gospel-centric biblical lens.
